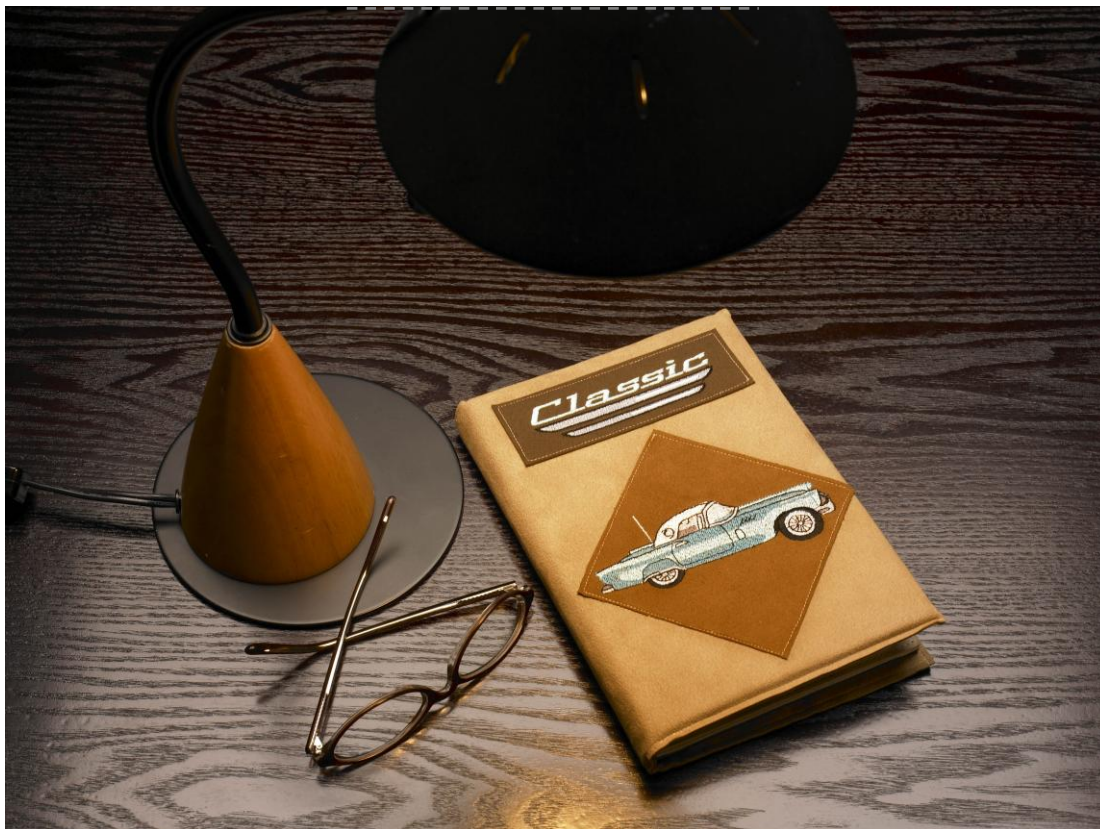


## "E-READER COVER"



With the use of a classic car design from an Amazing Designs design collection, you will be reading in style with your new e-reader cover. Personalizing your eReader with your favorite classic car is easy as it gets.

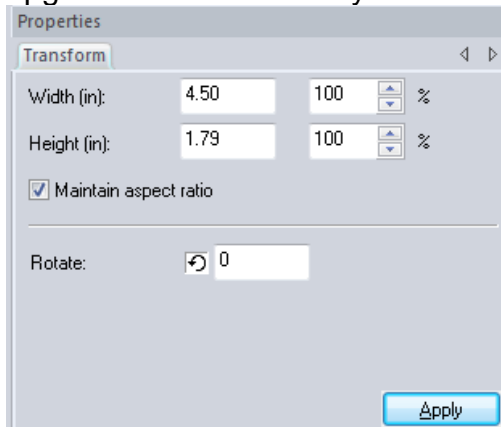
## Supplies:

Baby Lock® Ellisimo sewing and embroidery machine, using the 200mm x 200mm frame and Perfect Positioning Sticker  
Amazing Designs Classic Cars (ADC-109J)  
CustomWorks II from Designer's Gallery editing software  
½ Yard of beige Sensuede™  
1 Piece of dark brown Sensuede™ 5" x 1½"  
1 Piece of light brown Sensuede™ 4" square  
Madeira rayon embroidery threads to match thread chart provided with design  
Madeira Aerofil Thread for topstitching (#9855)  
Baby Lock Stick-Tear, Tear-Away stabilizer from Baby Lock (BLT102)  
Chalko marker  
Hook and Loop fastening tape  
E-Reader with purchased cover

## At the Computer:

### Car and Letter Designs:

1. Open CustomWorks II or any editing program and click on the Merge Design icon on the top toolbar. Retrieve design #car114.pes from the saved location.
2. With the design selected, click on the Transform tab under the Properties and resize the design width to 4.50" and click on Apply. Or if you have the upgrade for the Ellisimo you can resize the design in the machine.



3. Turn the embroidery machine on and attach the one end of the communication cable to the computer and the other end to the machine.
4. Attach the embroider unit to the machine.
5. Click on the Save icon and send the car design to the machine via the communication cable.

## At the Embroidery Machine:

1. Cut a piece of stabilizer to fit the size of the hoop.
2. Place the stabilizer in the hoop making sure the removable paper side faces up. Using a pin, lightly score the removable backing only along the inside frame of the hoop. Do not cut through the stabilizer. Remove the top layer of the paper.
3. Using a Chalko marker, mark the center on the 4" square of light brown fabric. Turn the fabric so that it looks like a diamond shape. Place the fabric

- in the center of the hoop with the points on the fabric placed towards the sides of the hoop even with the positioning marks on each side.
4. Place the Perfect Positioning Sticker over the center chalk line and place the hoop on the embroidery unit.
  5. Select the Positioning icon on the machine so that the machine will locate the Positioning sticker and adjust the placement of the design.
  6. Embroider the design using Madeira rayon threads according to the color guide.
  7. Cut another piece of stabilizer to fit the size of the hoop.
  8. Place the stabilizer in the hoop, making sure the removable paper side faces up. Using a pin, lightly score the removable backing only along the inside frame of the hoop. Do not cut through the stabilizer. Remove the top layer of the paper.
  9. Using a Chalko marker, mark the center on the dark brown Sensuede™ 5" x 1½" section. Place the fabric in the center of the hoop. Place a Perfect Positioning Sticker over the center mark on the fabric.
  10. Retrieve the "Classic" letter design from the saved location.
  11. Select the Positioning icon on the machine. The placement of the design will be adjusted.
  12. Embroider the design using the Madeira rayon threads.
  13. To create a personalize pocket on the inside cover; select a font from the built-in fonts in the machine. Enter in your first, last and middle initial, setting the size of the font to medium.
  14. Cut a section from any of the scraps of Sensuede that measures 3½" x 3½".
  15. Place a Perfect Positioning Sticker on the center of the piece and select the Positioning icon to adjust the positioning of the lettering.
  16. Embroider the lettering using a dark brown Madeira thread color.

### **Assembly:**

1. Place the beige Sensuede fabric on a flat surface and lay the opened eReader Jacket on top. Using a Chalko liner marker, trace around the outer edge of the eReader jacket. Before you cut out the section, allow for ¼" seam allowance and 5½" on both sides of the cover, which will create the sleeve that you will be sliding the jacket into. Cut out the section.
2. Place the embroidered car and "Classic" lettering design patches on the front of the cover. Using the Madeira Aerofil thread, top stitch close to the outer edge of the embroidered section. Refer to the picture for placement of the designs.
3. Place the monogrammed pocket on the inside flap of the cover and top stitch around three of the sides, leaving the top open.
4. With wrong sides together, fold the 5½" flaps to the inside and topstitch around the top and bottom outer edges.
5. Insert the purchased eReader cover inside the sewn cover.
6. To hold the back cover in place, attach a piece of self-adhesive hook and loop tape.
