Book “Easy to make Totes with Zippers by Cindy Taylor Oats” (TMB-155) (Red and Green Tote –page 7)

Variety of colors of embroidery thread

Stabilizer

Muslin fabric for base fabric

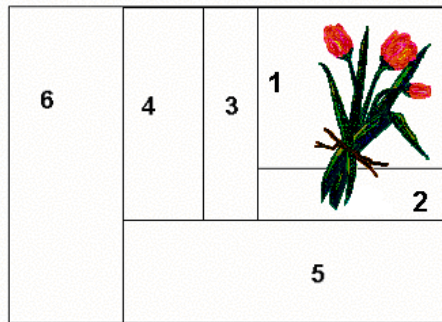
6 to 8 different fabric prints or textures (see pattern in



book for exact yardage requirements)
Cotton filler cord for handles
6 assorted size buttons to cover
Magnetic purse snap

Instructions:

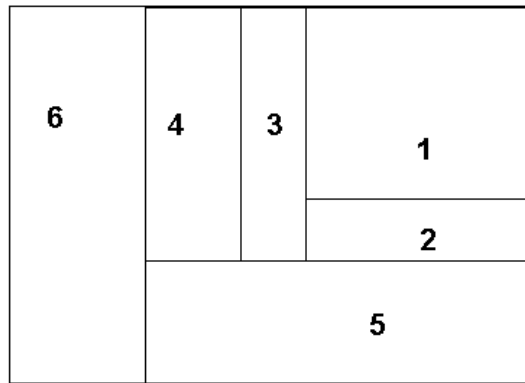
1. The fabric colors for the tote bag were selected to enhance the “Tulip” designs. The original pattern design called for a red and green color combination.
2. Section “**one**” and “**two**” were stitched together before embroidering the large tulip design to accommodate the size of the design.



3. Three small tulips were embroidered on section “**six**”.



4. The following built in Baby Lock decorative stitches were used:
 - Section 1 and 2 used stitch number 1-05
 - Section 1, 2 and 3 uses stitch number 6-013
 - Section 3 and 4 uses stitch number 6-052
 - Section 2, 3, 4, and 5 uses stitch number 6-066
 - Section 4,5 and 6 uses stitch number 6-137



5. Buttons were covered in two sizes to go on section 4.
6. The main tote bag was assembled as per the instructions in the book "Easy to make Totes with Zippers by Cindy Taylor Oats"

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
